Pursuant to section 1.1200, et seq., of the Commission's Rules, the International Association of Audio Information Services, Inc. (IAAIS) hereby notifies the Commission of the following ex parte presentations regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

On August 29, 2000 IAAIS Immediate Past President David Noble met with Chairman Kennard and FCC staff members Julie Barrie, Suzanne Zwerling and Jane Mago at the Chairman's office concerning potential interference to radio reading services from LPFM.

David Noble and IAAIS Board member Mike Duke participated in a follow-up phone conversation on September 6, 2000 with FCC staff members Jane Mago, Julie Barrie, Alan Stilwell and Kenneth Nichols. A final phone conversation on the same subject matter occurred between David Noble, Suzanne Zwerling, Julie Barrie, and Jane Mago on September 8, 2000. Both phone communications concerned the potential for interference to radio reading services from LPFM and the performance of SCA receivers as tested at the FCC's Columbia Lab.
