On January 8, 2001 the undersigned, met with Mr. Bryan Tramont, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Harold Furchtgott-Roth, to discuss the above-referenced proceeding.

The discussion centered on the timing of the release of NTIA's GPS and Non-GPS testing reports. We talked about the systems NTIA likely would be testing in their Non-GPS testing efforts. I suggested that the FCC's Office of Engineering & Technology coordinate with NTIA on their testing efforts. The need for timely Commission action was discussed.
