Dear Ms. Salas:

On February 13, 2001, Dr. Michal Freedhoff of Time Domain Corporation and I met with Adam Krinsky of Commissioner Tristani's office regarding the above-referenced proceeding. In addition to matters previously argued in Time Domain's comments in this proceeding, we emphasized the need for the Commission to expeditiously evaluate additional technical data filed in this proceeding and to act in the near term. We also re-emphasized Time Domain's commitment not to cause harmful interference to existing users, welcomed the opportunity presented by the recent report of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration to reach some accommodation with incumbent users, and indicated that Time Domain would shortly file a detailed analysis of NTIA's report
