On Wednesday, March 28, 2001, Dorothy Attwood, Chief of the Common Carrier Bureau, David Solomon, Chief of the Enforcement Bureau, James Schlichting, Deputy Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Warren Hight, CEO and General Manager of the SRT Communications, Brad Ramsey General Counsel for the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners and Daniel Mitchell, Senior Regulatory Counsel for the National Telephone Cooperative Association (NTCA) were part of a Regulatory Panel discussing state and federal issues as part of NTCA's 2001 Legislative Conference.
