This is to note that on April 3, 2001, Mimi Dawson of this firm and I met with Bryan Tramont, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth, and Mark Schneider, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Ness, on behalf of Time Domain Corporation. We emphasized the need for the Commission to move toward a report and order rather than a further notice of proposed rule making. In this connection we noted that the Commission staff should be encouraged to engage in dialog with NTIA looking toward rules that could lead to the implementation of UWB on a Part 15 basis. To that end we expressed the view that the rules should include those key elements for which the NPRM requested comment.
