
Dear Ms. Salas:

This is to note that on April 19, 2001, Jeff Ross, Michal Freedhoff, and Rachel Reinhardt of Time Domain Corporation accompanied by Philip Inglis of TRB Consulting, David Hilliard of this firm, and I met with Julius Knapp, Dr. Michael Marcus, John Reed, and Lisa Gaisford of the Office of Engineering and Technology.

We discussed the issues raised in Time Domain's comments and reply comments filed in this proceeding, including UWB applications and the positions advanced concerning various emissions limits, peak-to-average limit, measurement procedures, and the results of the UWB compatibility testing programs. We also reiterated the need to come to a timely resolution of this proceeding in order for the benefits of short-range, low powered UWB devices to be made available.
