
Dear Ms. Salas:

On behalf of Delphi Automotive Systems Corporation ("Delphi"), and in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.1206(b), undersigned counsel hereby submits the instant notice of *ex parte* presentation.

Specifically, on September 19, 2001, undersigned counsel met with Julius Knapp, Karen Rackley, and John Reed of the Commission's Office of Engineering and Technology ("OET"). Also participating in the meeting via teleconference was Nicholas P. Morenc, Delphi's Engineering Director at H E Microwave, as well as John Reed, Delphi's Senior Staff Engineer. In that meeting, various issues were discussed in connection with Delphi's most recent *ex parte* comments that were submitted with the Commission on July 13, 2001, along with an engineering study. In the meeting, Delphi re-emphasized the potential applications associated with automotive radar technology, including pre-crash sensing, occupant sensing, security systems and back-up aids. Delphi also provided information relevant to the issue of occupant sensing, as set forth on the website for Kids 'N Cars, a non-profit organization addressing automotive child safety issues, whose website is www.kidsncars.org.
