Dear Ms. Salas:

This is to note that on October 29, 2001, Jeffrey Ross of Time Domain Corporation, Richard E. Wiley of this firm, and I met with Mr. Julius Knapp, Deputy Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, to discuss the ultra-wideband proceeding. We noted the need for decisions in this proceeding to be based on realistic scenarios and good science. We also explained that if there were to be an indoor only restriction for certain UWB communications devices, the emissions limits proposed in the NPRM would be a conservative approach to such operations. At the same time, we noted the need for public safety applications of UWB technology that would of necessity involve intermittent outdoor operation and the need for application of the Part 15 general limits in such cases.
