Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, we hereby submit this notice of *ex parte* presentation.

On November 28, 2001, the group of individuals listed below met with Commissioner Abernathy, Bryan Tramont, and Jason Scism. We discussed the proposal submitted to Commissioner Abernathy and other Commissioners on November 15, 2001 by a coalition of companies and associations. The group expressed its concerns regarding issues of interference from UWB devices; that Part 15 was not an adequate vehicle to resolve such concerns, and that affected parties have not had an opportunity to examine and respond to the Commission's proposed rules prior to their final adoption. For this reason final action by the Commission should be deferred until such an opportunity is provided.
