On behalf of Delphi Automotive Systems Corporation ("Delphi"), and in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.1206(b), undersigned counsel hereby submits the instant notice of *ex parte* presentation.

Specifically, on January 28, 2002, undersigned counsel met with Commissioner Kevin J. Martin and Emily Willeford, Special Assistant to Commissioner Martin for Legislative and Public Affairs. In that meeting, undersigned counsel discussed certain of the various issues raised in Delphi's Comments, Reply Comments and Ex Parte Comments that were filed with the Commission on September 12, 2000, October 12, 2000 and July 13, 2001, respectively. The focus of the meeting, however, was the feasibility of Delphi's proposal for an allocation of a 24.125 GHz center operating frequency for automotive radar devices, and NTIA's apparent opposition to such proposal.
