
**Re: Amendment of Part 2 of the Commission's Rules to Allocate

Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, I am writing on behalf of NEC America, Inc. ("NEC") to notify you of two *ex parte* meetings that occurred at the Commission on April 8, 2002 in connection with the above-referenced proceeding.
