

1. 861-869 MHz public safety and business incumbents should have to relocate to 851-861 MHz only if all moving costs are paid.
2. There should be no mandatory frequency change required for existing licensees below 861 MHz.
3. The 851-861 MHz band should be "refarmed" to 12.5 khz steps. The new offset channels should be made available where frequency coordination determines that narrowband operations can exist without causing interference to existing licensees.
4. 851-861 MHz frequencies that are made available through the rebanding process should be made available first to public safety agencies that qualify through their NPSPAC plan process for two years and then split with 851-856 MHz assigned to public safety and 856-861 MHz to business applicants, providing that public safety maintains spectrum equal to its current allocation.
5. If Nextel is given an assignment in another band as a result of this proceeding, they should be required to relinquish their 800 MHz licenses.
