Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 26, 2002, the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association ("CTIA") represented by Tom Wheeler, President and CEO, Steven Berry, Senior Vice President for Government Affairs, and Diane Cornell, Vice President for Regulatory Policy, met with Chairman Powell, his Senior Legal Advisor Peter Tenhula, and Kevin Leston, an intern in the Chairman's office. The parties discussed issues relating to the pending proceeding considering additional spectrum for advanced mobile services. In particular, the parties discussed the status of the NTIA report on Government spectrum, and of the Commission's companion report on commercial spectrum in the 2110-2170 MHz band. CTIA emphasized that the Commission should reallocate 60 MHz and make it available for auction in the 2110-2170 MHz band, regardless of how much spectrum is made available for commercial services in the 1700 MHz band.
