Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 24, 2002, Van Greenfield, the Chairman of the Official Creditors' Committee ("Committee") of Globalstar, L.P. ("Globalstar"), and Tom W. Davidson and Phil Marchesiello, communications counsel for the Committee (collectively "Creditors"), met with several Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") representatives. The Creditors met separately with Paul Margie, Legal Advisor for Commissioner Michael Copps; Bryan Tramont, Senior Legal Advisor for Chairman Michael Powell, and John Branscome, Acting Legal Advisor for Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy. In each meeting, the Creditor's discussed the proposal recently discussed in the telecommunications trade press (and attributed therein to the Commission) to auction Mobile-Satellite Service ("MSS") spectrum that is surrendered by current MSS licensees in return for some type of bidding credit. In addition, the Creditors discussed the current financial condition of Globalstar. The Creditors emphasized the importance to Globalstar of expeditiously resolving the pending, above-referenced proceeding.
