Re: Applications for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses from Comcast Corporation and AT&T Corp., Transferors, to AT&T Comcast Corporation, Transferee, MB Docket No. 02-70

Dear Ms. Dortch:

AT&T Corp. and Comcast Corporation file this letter to supplement the record in the above-captioned docket regarding the attributable programming interests of the combined company post-merger. It has recently been discovered that the Application inadvertently omitted Empire Sports Network, L.P. ("Empire Sports") from the list of programming networks in which the merged company would hold attributable interests.

Empire Sports is a limited partnership whose sole general partner is Parnassos Communications, L.P. ("Parnassos"). Adelphia Communications Corporation ("Adelphia") (through indirect wholly owned subsidiaries) holds a 66.57% general partnership interest and a 0.1% limited partnership interest in Parnassos. AT&T Broadband (through an indirect wholly owned subsidiary) holds a 33.33% general partnership interest in Parnassos. By contract, Adelphia is the exclusive manager of the business and operations of Parnassos, including Empire Sports. AT&T Broadband has not been involved in the management or operation of Empire Sports, either directly, or through Parnassos or Adelphia.
