Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 6, 2003, on behalf of the Official Creditors' Committee ("Committee") of Globalstar, L.P. ("Globalstar"), the undersigned had a telephone discussion with Barry Ohlson, interim legal advisor to Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, regarding the status of the above-reference proceeding and the likely timing of the release by the Commission of an order in the proceeding. I encouraged expedited Commission action and explained that Commission action is likely to facilitate the acquisition of additional financing by Mobile-Satellite Service licensees. In addition, we discussed Iridium's recent request that a portion of Globalstar's spectrum assignment be revoked and assigned to Iridium. I emphasized that Iridium's request is not pertinent to the Commission's ATC proceeding and consideration of Iridium's request should not delay grant of ATC authority to Globalstar.

Pursuant to sections 1.49(f) and 1.1206(b)(1)-(2) of the Commission's rules, this letter is being electronically filed with the Office of the Secretary.
