On January 23, 2003, Van Greenfield, the Chairman of the Official Creditors' Committee ("Committee") of Globalstar, L.P. ("Globalstar"), had a telephone conversation with Bryan Tramont, legal advisor to Chairman Michael Powell, regarding the above-referenced Commission proceeding. During the conversation, Mr. Greenfield discussed the positions taken by the Committee in its prior filings in the proceeding regarding gating requirements. Mr. Greenfield also emphasized the importance to Globalstar of expeditiously resolving the pending proceeding. Globalstar is seeking new financing and the Committee believes that the regulatory uncertainty caused by the lack of a Commission decision in the proceeding has hampered Globalstar's efforts.
