

I would like to comment on ET Docket No. 02-135. As an amateur radio operator I support the ARRL's comments in response to Public Notice FCC 02-322. I have used the amateur bands for almost 10 years with much of it in public service and emergency communications. One of the reasons I became licensed was to make myself available as a communicator in times of need want to see the frequency allocations we have safeguarded against commercial interests that may not see public service and emergency communications to be in their best interests.
