Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on February 21, 2003, the undersigned met with Barry Ohlson, Commissioner Adelstein's Legal Advisor for Spectrum and International issues, to discuss issues raised in and associated with the pending Notices of Proposed Rulemaking on Space Station Licensing Reform (IB Docket Nos. 02-34 and 00-248). In particular, the undersigned emphasized the importance of rapid implementation (*e.g.*, a 6-month time frame) of new international satellite allocation decisions taken at World Radiocommunication Conferences in order to avoid future backlogs in processing of satellite applications.
