**NOTICE OF EX PARTE PRESENTATION**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Earlier today, the undersigned, counsel to the Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. ("WCA"), met with Bryan Tramont, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Powell, and Shellie N. Blakeney and John Schauble of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding WCA's petition for reconsideration of the Commission's decision to freeze the filing of applications for new or modified MDS and ITFS facilities pending the completion of this proceeding.

WCA emphasized the adverse impact of the freeze and the resulting inability to deploy new broadband services is having on licensees, system operators and the public. WCA also noted that the legitimate concerns of the Commission over possible incursions into the auctionable ITFS "white space" and the establishment of additional facilities that might seek "grandfathered" status under the new rules can be addressed in the manner suggested by WCA in its petition, while at the same time avoiding most of the adverse consequences of the freeze.
