NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules, we are writing to report that on April 24, 2002, representatives of the License-Exempt Alliance ("LEA") and undersigned counsel met with Edmond J. Thomas, Chief, Office of Engineering and Technology; Bruce Franca, Deputy Chief, OET; Julius Knapp, Deputy Chief, OET; Lauren Van Wazer, Special Counsel, OET; and Michael Marcus, Associate Chief for Technology, OET, with respect to the Wi-Fi Alliance's above-referenced Petition for Rulemaking regarding allocation of the 5.470-5.725 GHz band for license-exempt services. The LEA representatives in attendance were Douglas Campbell, Vice President, AMA TechTel; Patrick Leary, Chief Evangelist, Alvarion, Inc.; and Mike Scullin, Vice President-Business Development, Vivato, Inc. The parties discussed the Commission's issuance of a *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in this proceeding, the technical rules that should apply to the new spectrum (including power levels), and issues related to the U.S. position at WRC-03 with respect to license-exempt services in the 5 GHz band generally.
