

It is my belief that this should be investigated further and that the FCC and interested parties should confer with countries that have already researched the matter.

It appears that other countries have already concluded that BPL/PLC is detrimental to users of the HF Radio Spectrum below 80 meters.

Due to the antenna like nature of power transmission lines, particularly in rural areas the transmission of data over power line would emit RF that would be harmful to existing radio users.

If BPL is to become a standard in the United States the providers should be responsible for notching out transmission of frequencies that cause interference with existing users.
