

I am EXTREMELY concerned about the proposal to put broadband net access on powerlines. This has the capability to nearly silence HF communications if not implemented well. HF (also known as "shortwave") RF communicatins may seem old-fashioned, but it remains a vital communications link, particularly in emergencies. Airliners, ships at sea, government agencies, NGO and relief agencies, missionaries, news agencies, amateur-radio operators, and many others all depend on HF communications.
