

I wish to express my deep concerns regarding the prospective development of PLC services in the US. As a licensed amateur radio operator, I believe the FCC has a duty to protect our HF spectrum from radio frequency interference.

In the past, the Commission has enforced its own rules regarding RFI which impedes the legitimate usage of designated radio spectra. It is abundantly clear that utilizing unshielded power lines to carry broadband information would cause broad RFI across the amateur HF spectrum.

Hams continue to play vital roles in our society, and it is encumbant upon the FCC to fully consider the effects of proposed technologies on its licensees.
