

I believe the Broadband over Power Line concept to be fundamentally flawed. Interference to users of the HF spectrum (as I am) will be forced to tolerate broadband interference, to the point of making the HF spectrum unusable. Power lines were designed to carry 60 Hz current, and is not a "sealed" system. Please discourage this technology until it can be a "sealed" system, as the current cable television system.
