

Dear Commissioners,

Broadband over power line is an ill-considered proposal. There is little chance that this proposal can be implemented without substantial increase in interference to multiple radio services, in unpredictable ways. The power grid system, including both outdoor lines and in-home lines has no design capability to conduct and contain high bandwidth digital signals. There may be some residential and commercial installations that can tolerate this class of service, but there are likely many more that will radiate high levels of electromagnetic interference signals. Please reject this proposal.
