

Dear Sirs,

As a amateur radio licensee, I am deeply concerned about the near certainty that BPL/PLC will produce RFI across a broad spectrum. We know from experience that accidental radiators produced by loose connections on power poles can produced RFI that obliterates ALL licensed services across the entire HF and low VHF bands, as power lines act as huge antennas. I am concerned that posted comments by the FCC suggest that the Commission is interested in changing Part 15 rules to allow the proposed BPL/PLC, rather than make the BPL/PLC comply with existing regulations regarding RFI. This seems to be in keeping with the Commission's tendency to favor almost ANYTHING large corporations wish to do, regardless of the harm it may cause the public, and other licensees. This is, in my view, and abdication of the Commission's duty to Congress and the public. I implore you NOT to allow BPL/PLC without extensive testing, and thorough review by other licensed services. Thank you.
