

Dear Sir/Madam:

Reference proceeding # 03-104, transmission of broadband data via power lines. I wish to express opposition to any scheme of this kind, as it would cause severe interference to communications in the 2 to 80 mhz communication bands as proposed.

We already have a lot of interference on some of these frequencies due to limited bandwidth power company data transmissions and other things such as solid state light dimmers. To put the proposed broadband data transmissions into effect on unshielded power lines would make this communication spectrum virtually useless, and would in effect make the original primary mission of the FCC of keeping the communications spectrum free of interference to legally licensed broadcasters null and void.

Please keep our off air communications as free from interference as possible by refusing to license or approve this power line transmission scheme.
