

Regarding Broadband over Power Line NOI -

Something the FCC might want to consider is the interference caused to the proposed BPL service by HF Amateur radio operations and other transmitters. For example, on the 10 meter band I transmit with about 10 KW effective radiated power because of the gain in my antenna. I think that such transmissions will probably interfere with digital data on power lines all over my neighborhood. Folks are not going to be to happy with loss of data when I am on the air.

In addition, as show by calculations at the ARRL the interference to be caused by BPL to HF operations is completely unacceptable.

I suggest you kill the idea of BPL now! Since when is the commercial interest places above the public interest?
