

I'd like to go on record as opposing BPL in it's present form.

The technology will cause harmful interference to both amateur and commercial radio signals. This in my mind would far outweigh any gains in internet availability that BPL would provide.

Large areas of the country would no longer have access to shortwave broadcast signals, MW broadcast, as well as amateur HF.

I urge the Commission to thoroughly test the potential for interference before considering changing the rules to permit expanded BPL operation, and carefully consider the results.
