

I am quite concerned about the possible RF emissions of this technology in the HF spectrum (reference - <http://www.arrl.org/tis/info/HTML/plc/>). Being a licenced amateur (N3OEA) and an avid shortwave listener, I am concerned that this technology will create undue interference in the amateur and shortwave bands. Although HF amateur radio is not as sexy as wireless internet, it is very often the only means of communication when the power goes out. And if the FCC would loosen its restrictions on the RBOCs, you would see more DSL penetration versus cable.
