

Please do not approve the use of broadband over power lines. As users begin to depend on this service, interference from users of the spectrum space may become a problem and require resolution that would limit their access to their spectrum allocation.

The broadband radiation from power lines would also cause interference to other spectrum users. Depending on the leakage from power lines, this could interfere with mobile users such as aircraft.

Weak-signal applications, such as amateur use, could also be compromised by leakage from power-line broad band.

Until this technology can guarantee that there will be no increase in the ambient noise level, I respectfully urge the FCC to disallow its use.
