

Good day. I am filing a comment on BPL because I, and many amateur (ham) radio operators are NOT in support of BPL. This will cause considerable interference to our amateur radio bands. Allowing BPL will make many of the amateur radio bands unusable or severely degraded. The present FCC Part 15 limits for this technology already can result in substantial interference potential to amateur frequencies. We don't need any more interference. Amateur Radio is a valuable resource which must be protected. The FCC has promised to protect licensed users of the spectrum, such as amateur radio. We must hold them to that promise.

It is an invaluable resource used in public service and emergency communications by many amateur radio operators, myself included. Please DO NOT allow BPL to be instituted. Protection of life and property may be hindered by amateur radio spectrum users in times of emergencies.
