

I strongly oppose the Broadband Over Power Line Docket - 03-104. The potential interference to the Amateur Radio Service (especially it's emergency communications capability) is not in the national interest. Amateur Radio operators already experience interference from power lines due to dirty insulators, poor connections, etc. Clearing up current problems is often impossible, even with the intervention of the FCC. Allowing broadband radiation from these unshielded power lines is the most ill-advised proposal I have encountered in my 49 years as a licensed Amateur Radio Operator.
