

I live in a rural area, and though I certainly wish broadband (DSL or cable) was available to me, it is not. As much as I would like high-speed internet access, BPL is NOT the way to achieve that.

Power lines were designed to bring 220 volts into homes, not internet access. BPL would turn all those power wires into giant radiating antennas, and the effects to existing radio services (including amateur radio) could be devastating.

Please do NOT approve BPL as an acceptable technology -- at least until ALL interference problems have been completely resolved.
