On June 18, 2003, The Industrial Telecommunications Association, Inc. (ITA); the Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials (APCO); and the law firm of Keller and Heckman, LLP, representing The International Association of Fire Chiefs, Inc. (IAFC) and the International Municipal Signal Association (IMSA) filed an ex parte notice with yourself in regard to a meeting with Chairman Michael Powell and Senior Legal Advisor, Bryan Tramont, discussing the above-referenced proceeding seeking to improve the CMRS interference problem in the 800 MHz band. In the ex parte filing, the parties inadvertently omitted a letter that was given to the Chairman during the meeting.

At the meeting, ITA, APCO and IAFC/IMSA provided the Chairman with the attached letter of the National Public Safety Telecommunications Council (NPSTC), responding to the City of Baltimore's request that NPSTC support the "Balanced Approach" plan for resolving 800 MHz interference.
