

In regard to the proposal to allow broadband services over power lines it is a known and established fact that this type of operation will create RF interference to all services below the Amateur 6 meter band. Tests in other countries show the interference to be of such a level that the Amateur Radio Service for one are rendered unusable on those frequencies. Japan has banned the broadband on powerlines operation.

For myself, as an Amateur Radio Op for more than 50 years (K6ERQ) if the Commission allows this type of interfering operation I will a) tear my Amateur Radio License in two and send it back to FCC and b) resign from ARES and c) In the face of the next disaster in our area I will just have a good laugh and refuse to help.

Of course it is well known that the current Commission is bought and paid for by special interests, as was shown in the action on Radio and TV station ownership which was just concluded.

I have no doubt that the Commission is well paid to see that broadband on power lines is the next outrage.

Seems like a disgrace to your offices to me, but then our Government is shot through with corruption at every level. What else would we expect.
