

I am firmly opposed to utilizing the power grid for purposes other than transmitting electrical power to its end users. The lines are unshielded and not well suited for interference free data transmission. The cable TV network is well suited to data tasks as is a fiber optic network which would not interfere with other services. The potential for interference to essential RF communications by power line data transmissions far outweighs the potential benefit to a public that is largely already served by data transmission services having far less potential for interference with other services.
