

I'm against allowing progression of Broadband over Power Lines (BPL). I've been active in Amateur Radio since 1976 and this is my first comment to the FCC, so you can be assured that BPL is a great concern of mine. I feel the interference introduced would effectively shut down Amateur High Frequency (HF) band usage, ending my hobby. I've seen the effects of BPL demonstrated, deployed within current FCC part 15 emission limits, and am sure that if widespread use was deployed the end of the HF use by all spectrum users is inevitable.
