

As a licensed Amateur Radio operator I am very concerned about the FCC's consideration of the BPL issue. The interference generated by this technology has been documented by the ARRL, and the magnitude of it is shocking. I am certain that the interference will impact not only the Amateur Service, but potentially all radio services in the HF and low VHF frequencies. It seems to me that if the FCC were to approve this technology they will be setting up a scenario where a large number of complaints are going to be generated, again not just from Amateur operators. I can see no benefit to this technology to anyone other than the power companies that want to make additional revenue by using their existing, expansive, and expensive, network of power lines. I urge the Commission to carefully review the impact that this technology will have on all radio services in the HF and low VHF frequencies before it even considers allowing this technology.
