

I am very much opposed to the use of high tension power distribution lines for the use of broadband wireless or other digital distribution. The use of these directly violates any shielding at all, and has been shown by recent ARRL underfunded studies to cause very serious interference to HF and VHF communication. This would be the death knell for amateur radio. The commission should decide whether they want to support the unlimited expansion of digital technology, or kill SWL and HF at the same time. Not to mention the interference that would be caused to conventional TV and AM broadcast band.
