I am writing to express my serious concern about the impact of Broadband Power Line on the Amateur Radio Service as a whole. Nonwithstanding the fact that I stand to lose a substantial financial investment (well over six thousand dollars) due to the fact that BPL operations will, for all practical purposes, make continued operating difficult or nearly impossible on almost all HF amateur frequencies, I must express sincere disappointment and shock that the Commission would allow the substantial public service aspects of my operations (FEMA, NWS-Skywarn, and other Public Safety activities in which I regularly participate) to be compromised or eliminated by its oversight of the devastating impact BPL has been recently shown to have on the Amateur Radio service.

I implore you to carefully investigate the dire negative impact to amateur radio operators and the general public safety that your allowance of the operation of BPL as it stands under Part 15 would initiate, and to prohibit BPL operations by any entity under the proposal before the Commission.
