

I am opposed to any implementation of BPL.

In my area I am already subject to high levels of unintentionally produced broad-band noise interference from the power grid that obliterates reception throughout portions of the VLF through HF spectrum.

I have observed this noise over a 5 square mile area in my vicinity at such high levels in some locations that it is impossible to listen to, for example, a 50KW clear channel AM Broadcast radio station 20 miles away.

BPL will provide yet another source of interference, this time intentionally produced. Based on my current observations, I expect that any additional emissions by the power grid will only exacerbate the interference problem in my area.

Since the power companies already fail to monitor and correct broadband noise in my area on a proactive basis, I am opposed to any implementation of BPL, regardless of the field strength limits.
