

I am respectfully asking the FCC to deny the use of power lines for the distribution of broadband computer data. From their comments, companies that will benefit from the action are apparently not concerned about actual interference but whether their transmissions meet part 15 regulations. Tests have shown that this technology (even within part 15 guidelines) does produce wide-spread interference which has the capability of disrupting important licensed services including public safety and safety. The question before the commission then is whether the profits of large companies are more important than the endangerment of the public from interference to the communications of public services.
