After now having had a chance to review some of the recent test results made publicly available by the ARRL (www.arrl.org), I am more concerned about use of this BPL technology. I strongly request that the FCC take steps necessary to protect us all from the interference this BPL will cause. Interference from use of this BPL will make the old "Russian Woodpecker" interference (remember it?) seem like a tame canary singing nicely - this BPL will grow into a screaming "Eagle" killer. The Great American Eagle will not even have a chance to coneract this "birdly" interference from air bourne BPL interference. It would be a great loss to see this BPL based interference infect the HF bands as the ARRL test results indicate.
