Dear Secretary Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, the Intelligent Transportation Society of America ("ITS America") hereby informs the Commission that representatives of the ITS industry met on August 7, 2003 with representatives of the Fixed-Satellite Service ("FSS") industry to continue their discussions of common technical and regulatory issues associated with the above-referenced proceedings. Attending on behalf of the ITS industry were representatives from ITS America, ARINC, Inc., and The Johns Hopkins University – Applied Physics Laboratory. Attending on behalf of the FSS industry were representatives from Intelsat, New Skies and PanAmSat.

This was a second meeting between these industry representatives to discuss a possible mutually beneficial accommodation regarding potential interference, coordination and licensing issues associated with ITS and FSS operations in the C-band and extended C-band frequencies, as noted in various comments filed in these dockets. The attendees have agreed to meet again in September 2003 and hope to provide the Commission with the results of their discussions shortly thereafter.
