Comment:

I have heard the evidence put together by the American Radio Relay League (ARRL) video which can be viewed on [http://216.167.96.120/BPL\\_Trial-small.mpg](http://216.167.96.120/BPL_Trial-small.mpg). This depicts the noise interference created by broadband digital transmissions over low voltage electrical power lines (BPL). These are like the power lines that are strung all over my neighborhood. Should the use of BPL transmissions at the industry proposed power levels be permitted, it would essentially eliminate the Amateur HF bands not to mention the HF broadcast band.

Therefore I, as both a listener of the HF broadcast bands and a potential future transmitter station on the Amateur HF bands, urge the FCC to limit the power levels of BPL to the levels proposed by the ARRL.
