

I'm in favor of BPL because it can bring some higher speed access to some very remote customers as long as:

- 1) They must not generate noise that interferes with the Ham Radio Bands and the FCC must truly enforce this issue.
- 2) BPL systems that get deployed must be completely tolerant of any legitimate use of the Ham Radio Bands that their Power Line transceivers perceive as interference. I don't want them to move in under the guise of "We don't Cause interference Per Part 15" and then a year later we lose the Amateur Radio Service because our Neighbor cannot stream live video on their home computer.
