

Allowance of the BPL passage will not only bother Amateur Radio operations in the affected bands, but cause interference within the homeland defense systems such as FEMA's SHARES HF operations, ARMY, NAVY and AIRFORCE MARS operations nationwide. During emergencies and disasters VHF/UHF frequencies that are authorized for these operations will be insufficient to carry all the required communications that will be demanded. This is not a viable way to provide commercial INTERNET at the detriment of this type of operations as well as amateur operations.
