**RE: Change Of Address Update For FCC Docket 03-104**

Dear FCC Commissioners and Staff,

I am writing this letter on behalf of THE AMHERST ALLIANCE. Amherst is a nationwide, Net-based advocacy group, founded in 1998, which supports Low Power Radio in particular and more open airwaves in general.

Amherst has filed Written Comments in FCC Docket 03-104, which concerns the FCC's possible authorization of BPL (Broadband Over Powerlines). In addition, today we are filing Reply Comments. We oppose an authorization of BPL, due to its widely acknowledged interference with existing uses -- notably including emergency communications over the Amateur Radio Service. These existing uses are clearly of greater value to society than the minor conveniences offered by BPL.

In any event, the record should be updated to reflect the following new information:

1. Amherst has recently acquired a Post Office Box, which serves as its new address. As noted above, the new address is: P.O. Box 186, Cheshire, Connecticut 06410.
2. The Members of Amherst have recently voted to change my title from "Attorney For THE AMHERST ALLIANCE" to "President, THE AMHERST ALLIANCE".
